### 2019 Tournament Rules

All rules interpretations will be handled and resolved by the Competition Committee.

- SCRAMBLE: Peoria scoring means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
- The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (but no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot.
- This procedure is repeated on every shot, including putts (which need to be taken within 3 inches of the marked spot).
- If the ball you choose to play is within a hazard, rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop a ball outside the hazard even if less than one club length away.
- Each team must use at least one of the tee shots of each team member on the front and back nine.
- Men tee off from white tees; women from red tees.
- Observe proper golf etiquette at all times. Avoid slow play and keep up with the group ahead.
- Pick a team captain. He/she will be responsible for scoring your round and turning in your card to the golf shop upon completion of play.
- Ties will be broken in accordance with USGA guidelines using the lowest HDCP holes.

### Etiquette:

- Smooth all marks made in bunkers.
- Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out.
- Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range.
- Balls may be cleaned on the green and ball marks repaired prior to putting. You may not repair spike marks prior to putting.
- ♦ Observe all local course rules.
- All players must wear spike-less shoes, golf-type slacks, shorts and collared shirts

### Hole in One

### Closest to the Pin

There will be 3 holes for this contest (7, 9, & 14). The ball must come to rest on the green to qualify. Put your name on the marker and move it to your ball location if you beat the existing mark.

On the 18th hole, the ball farthest from the tee and in the fairway will be the winner. Put your name on the marker and move it to your ball location if you beat the existing mark.
